"The will of a late Bunceton woman has named the Cooper County Court as trustees of a private rural cemetery. Presiding Judge Leonard Lang said this is the first time such a request has been made of the court.

Before she died in 1979, Mrs. Esther M. Reavis bequeathed \$5,000 to the court for the care of the Reavis - Carpenter Cemetery, a small cemetery on a farm near Bunceton, Mo. To be invested, and only the interest to be used for the maintenance of the cemetery; the principal, \$5000 must remain invested in total.

A Missouri Law written in 1939 allows county courts to act as trustees and custodians of perpetual care funds for cemeteries. Mrs. Reavis' will specifies, as does the state law, that the money will be invested in federal, state, county, or municipal bonds. The intent of the will is that the money be put in a secure, conservative type of investment. The court will have to find a bank to invest the money in some type of government bonds - then, find someone to do the actual maintenance. State law, however, says he is not compelled to maintain the trust fund or the cemetery but may appoint someone else to do it."

The land on which this cemetery is located was first owned by Mr. and Mrs. F. M. Fulkerson. It was then sold to Abraham Weight and still later to the Reavis family.
