Nancy I. née Zachary; wife of Joseph Higgerson; died 1868
Two limestone markers with cedar tree in between
Lucy; died circa 1853; a sister of Nancy I. née Zachary Higgerson; Note: Her will is recorded in
Cooper Co., Mo. Probate Court.
