History:

HENRY A. HOBERECHT, farmer, section 36. Mr. Hoberecht is of German parentage, both his father, Frederick, and mother, formerly Christina Kuhn, having been natives of Prussia. His grandfather, Henry Hoberecht, was one of the earliest settlers of the county, and located on the farm where Henry Hoberecht now lives. Frederick and Christinia Hoberecht reared a family of eight children, of whom Henry, the subject of this sketch, was the eldest. He was born January 13, 1851. He had four sisters and three brothers: Paulina M., wife of Charles Beck, died February 19, 1877 ; Sophia L., wife of Herman Erhardt; Frank H. (married T. Anna Bankson on 02 Oct 1888), Charles W., Rocenia H., Laura E., and John O. (married Laurie Finley) Henry A. was married June 11, 1874, to Miss Nancy J., daughter of James T. Wilson, originally of Adair county this state. Two children have blessed their union Sadie May (married Archie L. Farris on 19 Oct 1898) and Alma Bertie (married Ed Hasenback at Highland Cumberland Presbyterian Church in 1907) Mr. Hoberecht's parents both died of the pneumonia within less than a week of each other, the father, April 10, 1871, and the mother the 16th of the same month. The old homestead farm contains over 400 acres of land, about is third of which is fine bottom land. Mr. Hoberecht raises nearly 200 acres of grain, and also some livestock - cattle, hogs, horse, mules, etc. He and his wife are both members of the Cumberland Presbyterian church of Highland.

The Hoberecht family name is more commonly spelled Hobrecht. Frederick first owned the land in section 1 where this cemetery is found. On the 1877 plat map it is listed as being the property of the F Hoberecht Heirs. On the 1897 map it is listed as H. A. Hoberecht; as is 1915 and 1929. Despite this, by 1919, Ed Hasenback was known to be farming and living on the original Frederick Hoberecht land upon which this cemetery is located. Frederick or Fritz Hoberecht was known to be in Cooper County, Missouri as early as

26 Oct 1868 as a Justice of the Peace of Saline Township entered judgment for both him the defendant.

There are other Hobrecht families in Cooper County such as William Hoberecht who was in Cooper County as early as 10 May 1850; and married Karoline Kockner. Additionally a Frank Theodore Hoberecht from Prussia, Germany was naturalized in Sep 1853 in Cooper County, Missouri. The nearby Schmidt Family Cemetery is the final resting place of Ed and Alma née Hobrecht Hasenback. The Schmidt Family Cemetery contains individuals that predate Frederick and Christinia née Kuhn Hoberecht and are believed to be the parents of Frederick. The nearby Erhardt Family Cemetery contains the remains of Herman and Sophia Erhardt. It is known that Henry A. Hoberecht along with son John O. and wife, Laurie, are buried in Walnut Grove Cemetery in Boonville, Missouri. Therefore, I believe that only the five listed people are buried in this cemetery.
