The following information is what I know about the Klug Family Burial Plot on the Family Farm at Clark's Fork, Cooper County, Missouri.

In March 1998, the current owner, Wilbur Graff, graciously took us to the old homestead and allowed us to walk around the area. At that time we suspected but were not sure if there was a burial ground on the property. We didn't see any type of headstones or markers, and the Graff's said they hadn't seen any markers and had no knowledge that a cemetery existed on the farm.

We now have proof that there is a place designated as a burial ground on the farm. We found from a copy of the plot map of Township 47 North, Range 16, W.5th P.M. - circa 1876, showing the farm of J.A. Klugg (spelled with two g's), 84.86 acres in section 6. There is a cross denoting a burial ground at the edge of the trees just left of the center of the property.

From my research and deductions this is a list of the people possibly buried in the Klug Family Burial Plot on the Family Farm at Clark's Fork: (If I estimated the dates, or was not sure of the places, they are in parentheses.)
