History:

This cemetery was just across the road from the Concord Cemetery adjoining the grounds of the Lone Elm Christian Church. The lone Elm Christian Cemetery was across the road (on east side). The cemetery is partially destroyed. A few markers remain where trees and brush have been bull dozed together. This list of burials was prepared by Mrs. Estelle Snow in July 1967.

In recent years, the owner of this land, has expressed a desire for someone to "clear-up" this spot and restore some order there, as much as possible. The Concord Baptist Cemetery just across the gravel road has been beautifully restored.
