An old cemetery, located in Clear Creek Township, Cooper County, Missouri in the western part of the section on the present farm of Carl J. Twenter, about a quarter of a mile east of his home, in a woods.

**History:** 

There are many graves here marked only by native stones at the head. Will calls this the "Mitchell Family Cemetery". Later research reveals that the so-called "Mitchell Family Cemetery" is also known as the "Old Dillard Family Cemetery". Excerpt from article "Clear Creek Township is Interesting Area of this County" by Mrs. A. J. Hayes, Clear Creek correspondent for the Boonville Daily News: "On the Jake Deuschle Farm, now owned by Carl J. Twenter, is found another buying ground. I had often wondered why it was put there, in the woods, off the road. No road leads to the cemetery; one must cross a branch and go up a hill to find it; but I was recently told that an old log school house there and it was used as a "meeting house". No records were ever kept, but it is thought to be very old and it is overgrown with weeds and brush" by Mrs. Hayes. Miss Twenter says there may be as many as fifty graves here; many marked only by field stones, with no date; also that many are children according to the dates.
