History:

In earlier times this was known as the Boatright Cemetery and was used as a rest area and burial place.

The Pleasant Grove cemetery was established about 1850 and was used for burials for about 20 years and then virtually abandoned. It was reopened during the 1920's and used predominately for colored burials. In 1989 Mrs. James Wear said she had a list of burials for this cemetery and that some work was being done to restore the cemetery.

This cemetery now belongs to the City of Otterville and receives some care. A gravel road now leads up to the cemetery.
