When the Education Building for the Evangelical Church was being constructed the excavator unearthed a number of skeletons; probably six or seven in number. Not wishing to delay construction he excavator never told Wade Davis about the skeletons until later.

In researching a Civil War story there is mention of the Zeke Houx Cemetery located only a couple of blocks away from the old jail. Although the property lineage has not been researched, it is quite likely that the cemetery uncovered during the excavation of the Educational wing is, indeed, the Zeke Houx Cemetery.
