DUR OLD SETTLERS.

John Stoen, postmaster at Elkhorn, has resided in Cooper county since he was born in Tennessee in 1838. He has been twice married.

John M. Moore, farmer, of Palestine township, is fifty-one years old, and a native of Cooper county. He has been twice married. Mr. Moore is a member of the Methodist church.

George W. Roe, of Pilot Grove, is a native of Cooper, aged fifty-one years. He was married in 1856, and is the father of three children. In religion, Mr. Roe is a member of the Methodist.

Robert W. Son, of Palestine township, was born in 1828, near the place where he now lives. Mr. Son has been three times married, and is the father of five children. He is a farmer and the owner of a sawmill.

John Trivillor, of Otterville, is seventy years old, having his Albermarle county birthplace, and the father of four children. He has been a resident of Cooper county since 1839. In politics he is a Democrat.

Henderson Moore, of Palestine township, is forty-three years old, and a native of Cooper county. He was married in 1860, and is the father of three children. Mr. Moore is the owner of a large and well-tended farm.

John Williams, of Palestine township, was born in Virginia in 1830, and brought his father's family to this country ten years later. He owns a large and steadily improved farm in the same place. In religion, Mr. Williams is a Baptist.

John Roe is a native of Maryland, and was born in 1815. He has been a resident of Pilot Grove township in Moore county years. He is the father of seven children in Tellton, he is a Methodist. Mr. Roe owns a large farm near Pilot Grove. He is seventy years old.
