

A GOOD MAN GONE.

Wm. James Parsons, son of Wm. S. and Anne B. Parsons, died at his home in Prairie Home township, March 28rd, and was buried last Sunday at New Salem burying-ground, the Rev. B. Margerson conducting the services. ✓

Deceased was born September 28, 1857, and married Miss Hattie Rogers, May 8, 1883. He leaves a widow and two little girls.

The nature of the disease had puzzled the physicians and baffled all medical skill for several months, in view of which, and at the request of friends, a post-mortem examination was held by Doctors Teal, Poindexter and Stiffler. It was found that the linings of the stomach were entirely destroyed.

Mr. Parsons was a prominent young man in his neighborhood and was looked upon as one of Cooper county's best citizens.
