### Order of Publication.

IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF COOPER COUNTY,  
Missouri. February Term, 1890.

The State of Missouri at the relation  
and to the use of L. F. Starke, Col-  
lector of the Revenue of Cooper  
county, in state of Missouri,

vs.

Salina Smith, William G. Pendleton  
and Granville Smith.

NOW at this day, comes the plaintiff, by attor-  
ney, and it appearing to the satisfaction of  
the court that the defendant, Salina Smith, can  
not be summoned in this action, it is ordered by  
the court that publication be made notifying her  
that an action has been commenced against her,  
by petition, in the circuit court of Cooper county,  
in the state of Missouri; the object and general  
nature of which is to obtain a judgment at the re-  
lation and to the use aforesaid, for the sum of  
forty-eight dollars and seventy-five cents (\$48.75),  
being the amount of delinquent taxes, with in-  
terest and clerk's fees, on the following described  
real estate, situated in Cooper county, in the state  
of Missouri, to-wit: Eighty-five and 63-100 acres,  
the west half of northwest quarter, and forty-  
two and 76-100 acres, the northeast quarter of the  
northwest quarter and twenty acres the west half  
of the northwest quarter of northeast quarter, all  
in township forty-seven (47), range fifteen (15),  
and containing in all one hundred and forty-sev-  
en 76-100 (147 76-100) acres, more or less; together  
with commissions, fees and the costs of this pro-  
ceeding, and that the same be declared a lien in  
favor of the state of Missouri on the real estate  
above described; and unless she be and appear at  
the next term of this court to be begun and holden  
at the court-house in the city of Boonville in the  
county of Cooper on the seventh day of July,  
1890, and on or before the third day thereof (if the  
term shall so long continue, and, if not, then be-  
fore the end of the term) judgment will be enter-  
ed against her and the said real estate sold to sat-  
isfy the same.

It is further ordered that a copy hereof be pub-  
lished in THE BOONVILLE WEEKLY ADVERTISER,  
a newspaper published in the County of Cooper,  
for four weeks successively, the last insertion to  
be at least fifteen days before the commencement  
of the next term of this court.
