Costs in the Maddex Case.

Circuit clerk A. L. Haun has filed with the county treasurer a bill of costs in the case of the state of Missouri vs George Maddex, who was tried for the murder of his wife and acquitted by the jury at the May term of the Cooper county circuit court. The costs amount to a total of \$1,013.75. This of course includes the fees of all the witnesses in the case, those for the defendant as well as those for the state. Had the state been successful in the prosecution the defendant's witness would not have been paid by the state.
