John W. Deaver Dies—He was born in Bristol, Indiana, June 3, 1852, and passed away at the home on West Clayton street, Monday, December 31, 1928, age 76 years, 6 months and 28 days.

He came to Missouri when a young man, and on December 7, 1892, he was united in marriage with Miss Mary Cook of Forker, Linn county, Missouri. To this union two children were born: Noel Deaver of Moberly,

Missouri; Mrs. Orval Swank of Macon, Missouri, who, with the wife and her children, Mrs. Ona Fleming of Macon, and D. D. Baker of Meadville are left to mourn his passing. He is also survived by twelve grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

The funeral services, conducted by Rev. Walter E. Anderson, took place from the Pentecostal church, Wednesday, January 2, 1929, at 2:00 p. m., and the burial, under the direction of C. W. Hill, was made in Rose Hill cemetery.
