**THOMAS B. PULLEY, 72,
DIES AFTER LONG ILLNESS**

Thomas Braun Pulley, 72 years old, died at his home in Speed, Saturday, May 25, after an illness of several years. Five years ago he suffered a paralytic stroke, and has for the past three years been bedfast. Mr. Pulley was born December 8, 1865 at Tipton, and for the past twenty years has been a member of the Pleasant Hill Baptist church.

Mr. Pulley is survived by his wife, one son, Lennie Pulley, of St. Louis; one sister, Mrs. J. I. Hazell, of near Pilot Grove; and two granddaughters, Marie Bell and Bernadine Pulley.

Funeral services were held at the Speed Union church Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock conducted by Rev. Lamp, pastor of the Mt. Hermon Baptist church. Burial was made in the Mt. Hermon cemetery.
