

Arthur L. McNeil

Arthur L. McNeil, 71 years old, brother of Dr. Charles McNeil, passed away suddenly at his home, 1500 South Barrett avenue about 11:20 o'clock Sunday night. Death was due to heart trouble.

Mr. McNeil had driven to Otterville Sunday where he and his wife visited with his sisters for several hours. While there he became ill and returned home but later appeared to be feeling much better. About 11 o'clock he suffered a heart attack from which he failed to rally.

Mr. McNeil was a well-known Sedalian having come here from Otterville in the fall of 1910 with his family and at that time was engaged as a car carpenter at the M-K-T Railroad shops, where he was working until his death.

He was born in Elston, Mo., April 4, 1863, the son of the late P. T. and Sarah McNeil. February 19, 1896 he was married to Miss Nellie Finley of Otterville, and they resided there until coming to Sedalia.

Surviving are his widow, of the home, and two daughters, Mrs. K. R. Becker of Poplar Bluff, Mo., and Mrs. Luckett Smith of Hunnewell, Kas. One son passed away in infancy. Two brothers, Dr. George McNeil and John McNeil, preceded in death.

He is also survived by his one brother, Dr. Charles McNeil, and four sisters, Mrs. W. T. Leach of Otterville; Mrs. J. D. Keby of Jefferson City and Miss Margaret and Miss Lulu McNeil, both of Otterville.

Mr. McNeil was a member of the First Baptist church, of Granite Lodge, 272, A. F. & A. M. and of the I. O. O. F. Lodge.

The body was taken to the Gillespie Funeral Home and was returned to the family home Monday.

The funeral will be held at the Gillespie Funeral Home at 2:30 o'clock on Wednesday afternoon, the Rev. Dwight H. Willett, pastor of the First Baptist church, assisted by the Rev. A. W. Kokendoffer, pastor of the First Christian church, to officiate.

Music will be in charge of Mrs. Roswell Beach.

Pall bearers will be Dr. H. B. Blount, Dr. J. G. Love, Leonard Milburn, Harry Everett, the latter of Otterville; "Dick" Cranmer, of Otterville, and Peter Fabe of Warrensburg.
