SHANNON FUNERAL SERVICES SUNDAY

Burial Made In the Walnut Grove Church Cemetery; Rev. H. C. Clark Officiating

Funeral services for Al Shannon were held Sunday afternoon at the family residence, in the Clark's Fork community. Mr. Shannon passed away Friday afternoon following an illness since Sunday of pneumonia.

The services were conducted by Rev. H. C. Clark of Boonville and burial was made in the Walnut Grove cemetery. Pallbearers were Terrell Mills, Luther Debo, Harold Mills, D. Windsor, Ben Harned, Jr., and Henry Windsor.

Robert Alexander Shannon was born April 26, 1880, the son of Elza and Mary Miller Shannon. He was married in 1901 to Miss Anna Eldridge, and to this union were born the following children, who survive: Norman of Boonville; Miss Laura of St. Louis; Mrs. Willard Marshall of Blackwater; Gilbert of St. Louis; R. A., Jr. and Faye of the home, one child dying in infancy.

Mr. Shannon is also survived by his widow, his father, a brother, Elza M. Shannon, and four half-brothers and sisters: Mrs. Vivian Mills, Noye, George and Louis Shannon.
