

Otterville Woman Dies At Age of 88

Mrs. Margaret "Brownfield," 88, died at her home in Otterville Tuesday night, Jan. 17. She was born Jan. 4, 1851, in Cooper county, and married James E. Neal of Otterville in 1872, to which union seven children were born, three of whom preceded their mother in death. Mr. Neal died in 1889.

Mrs. Neal was married again on July 7, 1910, to John C. Brownfield, with whom she resided in Sunnyside Wash., until Mr. Brownfield's death in 1922. Since that time she lived at Otterville.

Surviving children are Mrs. A. H. Speaker of the home, Mrs. Nora Cramer, Eugene, Ore.; William Neal and Elmer Neal, both of Kansas City. One brother, Caleb Weeden of Wagoner, Okla., eleven grandchildren and 29 great grandchildren and one great, great grandchild also survive.
