MRS. LAURA RUNKLE DIES AT HOME OF DAUGHTER

Funeral Service Will Be Held At
Baptist Church Friday After-
noon At 2:30

The body will be moved from the Stegner-Koenig funeral home this evening to the Drennen home where it will lay in state until time for the funeral services.
