

.22 Rifle Accident Fatal To Child, 7

OTTERVILLE—Dale Arthur Bane, seven-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. L. A. Bane, the victim of an accidental .22 rifle wound, was buried Sunday in the Otterville cemetery. Funeral services were conducted at the Presbyterian church at Otterville by the Rev. G. A. Craig, pastor of the Baptist church.

Dale Arthur died at the Bothwell hospital, Sedalla, early Saturday morning. He was admitted to the institution Friday evening, suffering from the rifle wound.

He had accompanied his father and two brothers to the country home of Mr. and Mrs. John Reed, two miles south of Otterville. His father and two brothers left the car, leaving Dale Arthur alone in the machine. In some way the gun was discharged, wounding him fatally.

He is survived by his parents, two brothers, Max Bane and A. Bane, and a sister, Nadine Bane, and a half-brother, Loren Bane.
