Old Antioch Baptist Church Torn Down

OTTERVILLE--The old Antioch Baptist church building seven miles northeast of Otterville was sold last Saturday to Leonard Stahl of Syracuse. The church brought \$70 and the furnishings \$30, making a total of \$100.

The building will be razed and the material used for improvements at Mr. Stahl's home.

The Antioch Baptist Church association was organized in 1872 and the building was erected in 1878. Services were held until the past few years. The removal of this building marks the passing of a familiar landmark in southwest Cooper County.
