Dies Unexpectedly After Heart Attack

OTTERVILLE — Charles William Homan, 70 years of age, died unexpectedly at 7:30 o'clock Wednesday August 8, following a heart attack. Homan, a farmer, was born Oct. 29, 1874 in Morgan county. He was married on Oct. 20, 1898 to Miss Rose Myrtle Yarnell, who survives him. In addition to his widow, Homan is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Clyde Manning, of Sedalia, one granddaughter, Miss Anna Belle Reed of Sedalia, a sister, Mrs. L. C. Coffelt of Las Animas, Colo., and a brother, O. L. Homan, of Otterville. He also leaves several nieces and nephews. Funeral services were held at 2:30 o'clock Friday afternoon at the Presbyterian church with the Rev. Ernest Waite, pastor of the Otterville Baptist church, officiating. The service was under the direction of the

Parker Funeral Service in Otterville.
