Mrs. Charles Monsees

Mrs. Amella Catherine Monsees, 70 years old, wife of Charles Monsees, died at 1:10 this morning, after having been in ill health for the past two years.

Mrs. Monsees was born October 23, 1888, the stepdaughter of the late John D. and Catherine Monsees, one and a half miles south of Smithton.

On October 20, 1888, she was married to George Demand. Four children were born to this marriage, three of whom survive: Mrs. Stanley Kahrs, Raymond Demand, both of Smithton, and Homer Demand, Hartford, Conn.

Mr. Demand preceded her in death in October, 1901.

She was married to Charles Monsees in 1916.

Also surviving are two sisters, Miss Emma Monsees, Smithton, and Mrs. Benjamin Johanson, Cincinnati, Ohio, and one granddaughter, Mrs. Nadine Moore, of Nevada.

Funeral services will be held at 2:30 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at the Neumeyer funeral home in Smithton, with the Rev. Earl Dillon officiating.

The body will remain at the Neumeyer funeral home until after the services.

Burial will be in the Smithton cemetery. ✓
