Funeral services for Mrs. T. B. Stone, who died at her home at Clifton City Wednesday evening, at 8:30 o'clock were held at the Methodist church in Clifton City at 2:30 o'clock Saturday afternoon with the Rev. H. A. Wood, pastor of the church officiating.

A trio composed of Mrs. William Todd, Mrs. Add Johnson and K. C. Mullen sang "Beautiful Isle," "The Old Rugged Cross," and "Rock of Ages," with Mrs. C. J. Reuter as accompanist.

Pallbearers were J. G. Harlan, Andrew Gerke, Sherman Todd, Hubert Agler, Harry Hazlett and Lee Croft.

Interment was in the New Lebanon cemetery.

Mrs. Stone was born March 22, 1874, near Bellair, the daughter of the late Deverix and Mary Pulley. All her younger life was spent in that community. She was married to Mr. Stone of Speed, Mo. in 1899 and later, with her

husband, moved to the Pleasant Green community where they resided until eight years ago when they moved to Clifton City. She was a member of the Pleasant Green church.
