Illness Fatal To Miss Ruth Mayfield

PLEASANT GREEN, Jan. 3—Miss Ruth Elizabeth Mayfield died yesterday morning at 4:25 o'clock at her home near Pleasant Green. She had been ill for several years.

Funeral services will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock at the New Lebanon Presbyterian church with the Rev. William Sampson of Prairie Home conducting the rites.

Funeral services will be James Allan Mayfield, W. B. Hurt, Robert Holman, A. C. Mayfield, D. B. Mayfield, and Arthur Wolfe. Burial will be in New Lebanon cemetery under the direction of Hays Painter. The body was taken to the family home at 10:30 this morning from the chapel in Pilot Grove.

Miss Mayfield was born Dec. 16, 1891 near New Lebanon, the daughter of the late William and Laura Licklader Mayfield. The family moved from New Lebanon to Pleasant Green in 1910. Miss Mayfield was a member of the Presbyterian church in New Lebanon.

Survivors include a brother, James W. Mayfield of New Lebanon; and two sisters, Miss Laura Mayfield of the home and Mrs. Ewing Hurt of Pleasant Green. She was preceded in death by one brother and two sisters.
