

Renison Rites To Be Tomorrow

Mrs. Sara Jane Renison, 77, died at ~~St. Joseph's Hospital at 11:20~~ a. m. yesterday. She had been ill since April 24 when she suffered a broken hip and wrist in a fall at her home at 107 East Morgan Street. Complications from the injuries resulted in her death.

Funeral services will be conducted by the Rev. Ross Fulton at the ~~Nelson Memorial Methodist Church~~ at 2:30 p. m. tomorrow. Burial will be in ~~Walnut Grove Cemetery~~. The body will be taken to the home of her son at 111 East Morgan St., from the Goodman and Boller Funeral parlors at 10 a. m. tomorrow. It will remain there until time for the rites.
