Mrs. Ella M. Croy, 86, died August 3, at 6 a.m. at 2200 East 10th, Sedalia.

She was born in Sterling, Ill. April 3, 1865 and the daughter of E. W. and Mary Katherine McMary. Mrs. Croy came to Barton county with her parents in a covered wagon when she was three years old. She had been a resident of Sedalia since 1908. She married John A. Croy March 30, 1887 in Barton county. Mr. Croy died January 20, 1923. Mrs. Croy was a member of the Broadway Presbyterian church.
