Mrs. Malinda Hurt Dies Suddenly

PILOT GROVE — Mrs. Malinda Hurt, who would have been 93 years old Jan. 2, died suddenly at her home here yesterday morning.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10 a. m. tomorrow at the Hays-Painter chapel here by the Rev. Carl Opp, pastor of the Methodist Church. Burial will be in Walnut Grove Cemetery. Pallbearers will be George Weamer, Russell Koonse, Arthur and Virgil Wolfe, Edward Ries and Charles Platt.

The body will remain at the funeral home until time for the rites.

Mrs. Hurt is survived by four sons, Chester, Huntsville, Tex., Raymond, Sedalia, Ewing of Pleasant Green, and Lewis of Pilot Grove; five daughters, Mrs. Homer Brubaker, Sedalia; Mrs. Lyde Powell, Denver; Mrs. Homer Carpenter, Tipton; Mrs. Jack Olson, Oklahoma City, and Mrs. J. D. Heinrich, Jr., Pilot Grove; 26 grandchildren, 26 great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandchild.

Mrs. Hurt was born at James town Jan. 2, 1862, the daughter of Thomas Benton Haley and Elizabeth Haley and was married to Boom Hurt, Nov. 9, 1880. He died a number of years ago. She was a member of the Pilot Grove Methodist Church.
