

Mrs. Selma R. Rennison

Mrs. Selma R. Rennison, 61, Route 3, wife of Edgar A. Rennison, died at Bothwell Hospital at 3 a.m. Friday. She had been in failing health for the past five years. She was admitted to the hospital Thursday.

Mrs. Rennison was born in Moniteau County, Mo., May 14, 1896, the daughter of the late Henry and Margaret Schuster Dietzel. Her girlhood and early life was spent in Moniteau County.
