George Henry Carey, 41, of 324 South Lawndale, was found dead in bed last night at his home. Officers found an open can of poison in the basement of the home and a glass on the kitchen sink which contained a residue of the poison. Mr. Carey was born in Steed, Mo., and reared in Boonville, Mo. He served in Europe in the Army Air Corps during World War II. Following the war he moved to Kansas City, where he has worked as a cosmetologist. He was a member of Bethany Baptist church. He leaves his mother, Mrs. Millie May McClary, and his stepfather, John R. McClary, both of the home, and a sister, Mrs. Ida Zumault, 611 East Seventy-second, North. The body was taken to the Sheil chapel.
