Hunting Accident Kills Glasgow Man

FAYETTE-Bryan Shifflett, 65. a farmer lifing approximately 10 miles north of Glasgow, died Tuesday morning as the result of an accidental shooting, which occurred while he was hunting on his farm. Dr. W. A. Bloom, Howard coun-

ty coroner who together with Sheriff Delgar Wells, investigated

the incident, stated that Shifflett's body was found by neighbors near a fence about noon. A .22 caliber-410 gauge rifle was found next to the body with the 23 chamber empty. A bullet hole was located in the temple. Shifflett's cap was caught in the
