Services Sunday For Mrs. Haley

Mrs. Basil Haley, 307 West Spring street, died at St. Joseph hospital Friday afternoon following an illness of three years with cancer.

Funeral services will be held at the Goodman and Boller Chapel Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock with the Rev. George Barger officiating. Burial will be the Walnut Grove cemetery.

Ferne Watson Haley was born in Jasper county, Missouri, August 18, 1904, the daughter of Albert E. and Elizabeth Mosher Watson. On May 29, 1925, she was married to Basil Haley at Bellair and they spent most of their married life in Boonville.
