Mr. Rupert P. Renison, 68, died at his home at 209 East High Street Sunday morning.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the Nelson Memorial Methodist Church with the Rev. Mark Horn officiating. Burial will be in Walnut Grove Cemetery, with graveside rites by the L.O.O.F. Lodge.
