Miss Carey's Services to Be Thursday

Miss Grace Carey, age 66, a lifetime resident of the Speed community died at noon Tuesday at St. Joseph Hospital following several weeks' illness.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Thursday at the Speed Union Church with the Rev. Jerry Clair officiating. Interment will be in Walnut Grove Cemetery. Friends may call at the B.W. Thacher Funeral Home until noon Thursday and then at the church.

Grace Cropper Carey was born at Speed on Sept. 20, 1902, the daughter of Charles Carey and Tabitha Burrell Carey. She is survived by one sister, Mrs. Harry Hein; one brother, Leslie Carey; a niece, Mrs. Gene Shaw; a nephew, Kenneth Carey; and an aunt, Mrs. George Bryan. One brother and three sisters preceded her in death.

Miss Carey was a member of the Speed Union Church, where she had taught a Sunday School Class for more than 40 years, had been assistant superintendent of the Sunday School and acted as choir director for a number of years.
