J. E. Hayslip Dies in Columbia

Johnny Ellis Hayslip, 62, died Sunday evening at the Health Care Center in Columbia. Mr. Hayslip was a former Marshall resident.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday in the Wilkinson-Hershberger Funeral Home. Burial will be in Sunset Memorial Gardens.

Visitation will be anytime after 1 p.m. today. Mr. Hayslip was born in Malta Bend, August 2, 1908, the son of Richard D. Hayslip and Frances M. Rockhold Hayslip. He was married June 1, 1932, in Kansas City to Nettie C. Crabtree, who preceded him in death Decem-

ber 3, 1968. He was a member of the First Church of God in Marshall and was a former pastor of the church, before retiring 20 years ago due to ill health. He was a past member of the Woodmen of the World, and was a former office employee of Bowler-Toffelmeire Plumbing Shop.

Surviving are two sisters, Mrs. Aubrey (Clara) Dickerson, Marshall and Mrs. Charles (Grace) Stephenson of rural Marshall; two brothers, Lloyd Hayslip, Marshall and C. Eugene Hayslip, Miami, Fla.
