NEW FRANKLIN—Hubert L. Smith, 81, New Franklin, died unexpectedly at his home apparently of a heart attack Tuesday afternoon, May 13, 1975.

The funeral will be at 2 p.m. Friday at the Markland Funeral chapel, New Franklin. The Rev. Jack Rowley will officiate and burial will be in Mt. Pleasant Cemetery, New Franklin. Friends may call after 3 p.m. Thursday at the Markland Funeral Home.

He was born Aug. 5, 1893, near Bunceton, the son of Peter Frank and Margaret Cordry Smith. He was first married to Edna Eichelberger. She preceded him in death March 7, 1956. In 1957 he married Mae Perrot, who she preceded him in death Jan. 30, 1968. He was a retired farmer and member of the Sedalia Methodist church. He had lived in New Franklin the last five years and was a lifetime resident of Howard and Cooper counties.

He is survived by two sons, Albert F. Smith and Lowell H. Smith, both of New Franklin; two daughters, Mrs. Cecil (Martha Sue) Brown, New Franklin; and Mrs. Jack (Eloise) Dixon, Springfield; seven grandchildren, seven great-grandchildren; one sister, Mrs. Edwin Briggs, Corpus Christi, Tex.; two brothers, Herschel Smith, Victoria, Tex.; and Homer Smith, Sedalia. He was preceded in death by three brothers and four sisters.
