Mrs. Anna Gertrude Morrissen, age 86, of Boonville, died Saturday afternoon at the Golden Hour Nursing Home in New Franklin.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the William Wood Funeral Chapel. Burial will be at Walnut Grove Cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home until time of services, with family visitation from 7 to 9 p.m. Monday.
