Mrs. Rose Smith Earickson, 90, died at Cooper County Memorial Hospital, this morning, May 4, 1978.

She was a resident of Colonial Gardens Retirement and Convalescent Care Facility and formerly a long-time resident of New Franklin.

Funeral services will be at 2:30 p.m. Saturday at the Markland Funeral Chapel, the Rev. Jeff Jackson officiating. Burial will be at Clark's Chapel Cemetery. Visitation will be after 4 p.m. Friday.

She was born Dec. 26, 1887 in Howard County near New Franklin, the daughter of William Wallace and Fannie Agnew Smith. She was married Sept. 24, 1913 to Herbert Cason Earickson. He preceded her in death Nov. 21, 1962.
