Don A. Elston, 91, Elston, died Thursday at St. Mary's Health Center.

He was born Aug. 23, 1891, at Elston, the son of George and Helen N. Moore Elston. He was married to Isabelle Shanks, who preceded him in death.



Mr. Elston attended the Elston schools and was an Army veteran of World War I. He was a member of the Baptist Church, the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, Capitol Lodge No. 37 IOOF and the American Legion Post No. 5. He had been active in the Democratic Party, serving as committeeman for 40 years and as treasurer for 12 years.

He was employed for 24 years by the Missouri Department of Revenue before retiring in 1957.

Survivors include one niece, Mrs. Helen Ashby of Port Richey, Fla., and one nephew, George Elston of Tulsa, Okla.

Services will be held at 2 p.m. Monday at the Buescher Memorial Home with the Rev. Billy Potter officiating. Burial will be in the Elston Cemetery.
