Bloom R. Faulwell

Bloom R. Faulwell, 86, of 120 Brook-
ing Park, died Monday evening, Jan. 9,
1989, at Bothwell Regional Health
Center.

He was born Aug. 22, 1902, near
Syracuse, son of James E. and Eliza A.
Steele Faulwell. On May 23, 1942, in
Warrensburg, he married Genevieve
Bond, who survives of the home.

Mr. Faulwell was raised and
educated in the Otterville area and was
a 1923 graduate of Otterville High
School. He attended Central Missouri
State University, Warrensburg, and
was a Navy veteran of World War II. He
was a member of Disabled American
Veterans and Otterville Presbyterian
Church, where he served as a deacon
and elder. He also was a member of
Sedalia Lodge No. 236, A.F.&A.M., the
National Association of Retired Federal
Employees and Otterville Senior
Citizens.

Other survivors include two sons,
Bond R. Faulwell, Overland Park,
Kan.; James A. Faulwell, Greenfield,
Wis.; a brother, Harry M. Faulwell, Ot-
terville; and four grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 2
p.m. Saturday at the church with the
Rev. Charles Spencer officiating.
