Mr. Henry Roberts, 74, died Thursday, September 5, 1996, at his home in Harrisburg. Funeral services will be conducted on Monday, September 9, 1996, at 2 p.m. at the Thacher Funeral Home. Henry Gabriel Roberts was born June 23, 1922, in Cooper County, the son of Roy and Ellen Gabriel Roberts. He was married to Nellie M. Sapp at Camdenton on August 5, 1940. Mrs. Roberts preceded him in death on January 22, 1991.
