Thurman Louis Stull, 64, of Columbia died Tuesday, May 20, 1997, at Boone Hospital Center.

Services will be held at 1 p.m. Friday, May 23, at Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints with Craig Israelsen officiating. Burial will be in Little Bonne Femme cemetery. Visitation will be from 6 to 8 p.m. Thursday, May 22, at Memorial Funeral Home.

Mr. Stull was born Jan. 8, 1933, in Columbia to Cecil Nelson and Edna Trimble Foley Stull.

He married Nancy Louisa Grabe on May 11, 1956, in Logan, Utah, and she survives.
