William Renison III, 64, of Taos, died of cancer Friday at his home. Mr. Renison was a mining engineer at MolyCorp, Inc. in Questa since 1969. He graduated from San Diego State University in California with an engineering degree and a masters degree from San Jose State University in California. He held a professional engineering license in the state of New Mexico and was a member of the Society for Mining, Metallurgy and Exploration for 27 years. He was also a member of the National Society of Professional Engineers since 1989. He was an Army veteran of the Korean War from 1953 to 1955.
