## Riley G. Edwards, 66

Riley Garnett Edwards, 66, of Boonville died Monday, June 19, 2000 at Boone Hospital Center in Columbia. Funeral services were at 11 a.m. Thursday at the Santa Fe Baptist Church with the Rev. Tim Faber and Rev. Chester Marshal officiating. Burial was in Walnut Grove Cemetery. Pallbearers were Gary Nivens, Steve Potter, Jeff Ward, Dan Potter, John Potter, and Larry Settle.
