## Maxine M. Fry, 85

Maxine Margaret Fry, 85, of Otterville, died Thursday, August 3, 2000, at Cooper County Memorial Hospital. Services will be Saturday, August 5, at the Otterville Presbyterian Church at 1:00 p.m. with Rev. Leo Birk and Rev. Farrie Cole officiating. Burial will be in Otterville. Visitation will be Friday 6-8 p.m. at the Meisenheimer Funeral Home in Pilot Grove. Visitation will also be Saturday 12:00-1:00 p.m. at the Otterville Presbyterian Church.
