Mildred Armina Nichols, 85, of Nelson, Mo., died Monday January 1, 2001 at the Bothwell Regional Health Center. Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Friday at the Memorial Baptist Church, near Nelson, Mo. with Rev. Robert W. Nichols and the Rev. David Faulkner officiating.
