**LT. COLONEL USMCR VICTOR  
WIECZOREK**  
FORMERLY OF NORTH PLAINFIELD

Lt. Colonel USMCR (Ret.) Victor Wieczorek of Doylestown, PA, formerly of North Plainfield, NJ and Dearborn, MI passed away on Thursday, April 29, 2010. He was born on May 7, 1920 in Detroit, MI to the late Stanislaw and Stella Zawadzka Wieczorek. Vic is survived by his beloved wife, Zona Johnston Wieczorek with whom he would have celebrated 66 years of marriage on May 13. Before his retirement in 1982, Vic worked 43 years as a hydraulic repair specialist for Vickers, Inc. Vic proudly served over 20 years in the United States Marine Corps including World War II and during the Korean Conflict when he was a pilot assigned to the aircraft carrier USS Rendova.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his three children, Delana Blore and her husband James of Doylestown, PA, Victor and his wife Cheryl of Solebury, PA and Marcy Rodriguez and her husband Jose of Bridgewater. Vic was blessed with four grandsons and their families: Scott and Christen Blore and their daughters Riley and Molly, Eric and Krista Blore and their children Amelia and Aaron, Cory Rodriguez and his fiancée Brienne Wilson and Ross Rodriguez. Vic is also survived by his sister, Alfreda Czarny of Doylestown, PA. He was preceded in death by his brother, Alphonse Wieczorek.

A private graveside service was held on May 4, 2010 at the Washington Crossing National Cemetery in Newtown, PA.
