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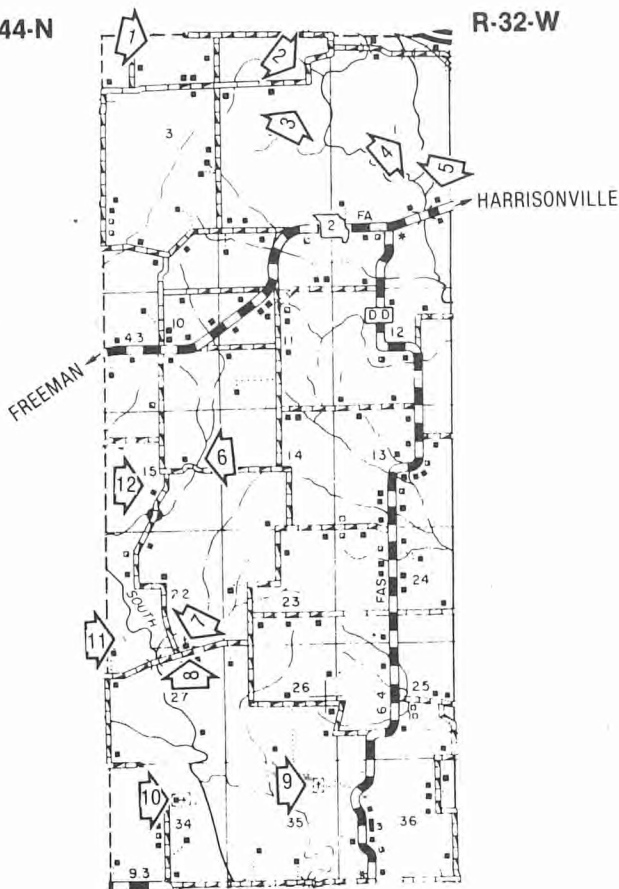

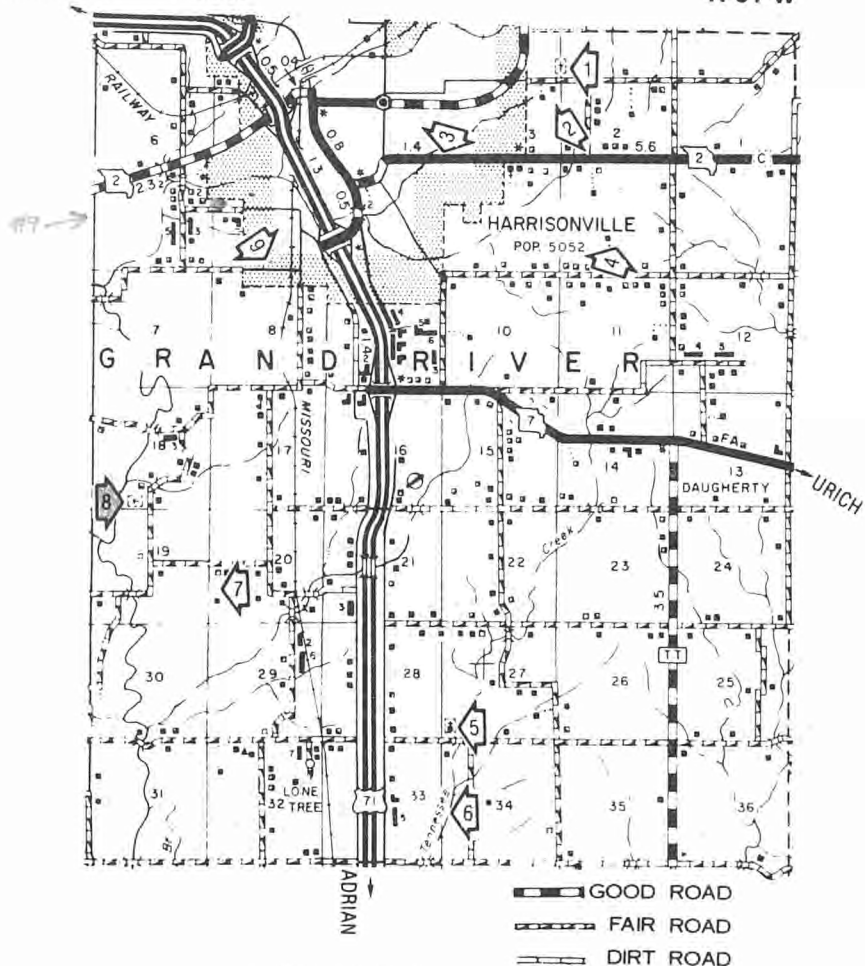

BRADY CEMETERY

Brady Cemetery is located about 4½ miles south of No. 2 Highway on Route DD in the northeast corner of Section 35, Township 44, Range 32. A country lane leads west from DD and ends at the cemetery which is not far from Grand River. This cemetery was a free cemetery until 1972 when an Association was formed to administer a trust fund for the maintenance of the grounds. All records were lost in a house fire. There are many unmarked graves. Slaves were buried in the southwest section. This cemetery carries the Brady family name. They were early settlers in this community. The Grand River Missionary Baptist Church was first located at this site with the cemetery west of their building. The church later built at the present location which is about 1¼ miles northwest of Brady Cemetery on the Grand River.

Some records state burial was made in Grand River Cemetery which may refer to this cemetery or to the Harper-Quick Family cemetery which was across the road from the present Grand River Baptist Church.

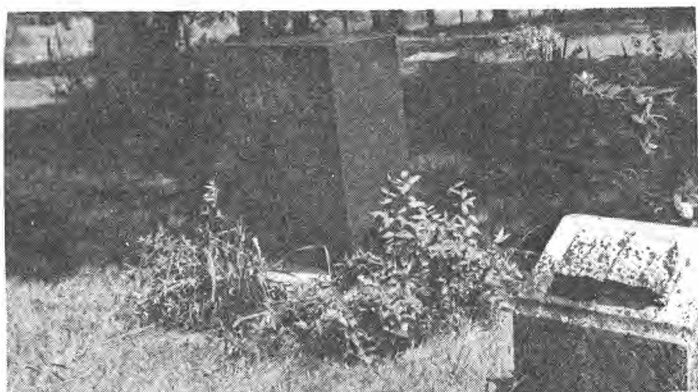

ADDENDUM: Information from HISTORY OF PLEASANT RIDGE CEMETERY by Charley D. and Anna L. Moore.

"John Antill was working in a sawmill in 1852 near where Clark's Bridge now stands. He died suddenly at this place and his fellow workers nailed up a box for him and buried him in the Brady Cemetery. Location of grave not known."

BRILES CHILDREN

Two Briles children were buried in the corner of the house yard of the farm located north of Highway No. 2 about 1½ miles west of Harrisonville City limits in Section 1 of Township 44, Range 32. Some years later new residents unaware of the location of the graves made the yard smaller which placed the graves in the barn lot. They were the children of Columbus Briles and died in the early 1900's during an epidemic.

BROOKS FAMILY

John L. Brooks and his wife, Eunica (Kelley) Brooks are buried on the farm to which they came about 1840. John L. was son of Dr. Lynch Brooks, the first physician in Harrisonville. The burial site is in the NW part of SW½ of Section 20, Township 44, Range 31. It is about a mile off the main road. The one stone is for Eunica.

BURFORD CEMETERY

This cemetery is located on a well traveled road about 2¼ miles west and south of the junction of Highways 7 and 71. It carries the family name of the Burford's, who were early settlers in this community.

An annual business meeting is held at the cemetery each year on or near Decoration Day - usually on a Sunday. Officers and one trustee are elected each year. The lots are endowed and the interst keeps the cemetery mowed and cared for. Flags are placed on Veterans graves each Decoration Day then removed after a few days and kept until the following year.

INDIAN CEMETERY

This obliterated site is now within the city limits of Harrisonville. It is located north of No. 2 Highway at the edge of the ridge where there is a drop to the creek. It was discovered years ago by some boys trying to dig a cave into the side of the ridge for a "hide-out". This burial ground is north of the residence at 1404 E. South Street.

McKINNEY CEMETERY

This cemetery is also known by the names of Bradley and Cleton. It is located in the center part of Section 2, Township 44, Range 32. This is north of No. 2 Highway about 3 miles west of Harrisonville. Most of the stones are of marble and very legible. There are large cedar trees. An ornamental iron fence with a gate surrounds the McKinney stones. The Cletons are buried at the northwest corner and the Bradleys are buried at the southeast corner of the McKinney's lot. PLEASANT RIDGE CEMETERY

The original grounds of the Pleasant Ridge Cemetery were deeded by James A. & Terrissia Hammontree to the trustees of the Pleasant Ridge Baptist Church namely, J. M. Cummins, Harris Jackson and Isaac P. Williams for the sum of \$15.00, on September 12, 1871. An additional two acres was purchased July 14, 1894 by the Church trustees, P. H. Taylor, David R. Hutchison and T. Lillard Holloway for \$40.00 from Terrissia Perry, widow of James A. Hammontree, Frelin Hammontree and Gilbert Holloway, curator for Jay and Ethel Hammontree. A member of the Atkinson family stated that some of the Atkinson graves were moved to this cemetery from the family farm in Coldwater Township. According to a local resident some graves were moved to Pleasant Ridge from a burial site about ½ mile south of the Church near the top pf the ridge on the west side of the road.

The G. A. R. Post at Austin, Missouri conducted Decoration Day services at Pleasant Ridge for years. Marjorie Patterson contributed the following account copied from a G. A. R. Record Book:

"At Pleasant Ridge people were slow in collecting and it was nearly 5 P.M. when the Adjutant called the house to order and called on Rev. Guinn, who made a 30 minute talk, after which position was taken at the grave of (Rev.?) (Leo?) Z. Hawley and Post Chaplain R. A. Bathurst, read

the GAR Service and the detail decorated the graves of John Headley, Jas. Clark, Matt Deaton, M. A. Keyes, J. P. Hammontree, James David and Jasper Holloway; also exconfederates Jas. Niel, Jas. Hammontree, after which ranks were broken to meet tomorrow at Austin at 2 P.M."

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PRICE OR WILLET CEMETERY

The Price or Willet Cemetery is located in a field north of No. 2 Highway about 1½ miles west of Harrisonville. It is in the NE corner of the SE ¼ of Section 1 township 44 Range 32. This cemetery was started about 1854 on the farm of Silas Price who came to VanBuren County (Cass) in 1843. He was born in Hampshire County, Virginia (now W. Virginia) and returned there in the spring of 1844 to marry Mary Ellen Brooke on April 23, 1844. They returned in 1845 to the house which Silas had built. Mary E. Price married John Nelson Willet in 1866. The first person buried in the cemetery was Thoms D. Brooke, a physician and the father of Mary Ellen. this cemetery Index was submitted by Joseph Brooke Price in February 1971 as his Community Service project for Eagle Scout. His great-great grandfather was Silas E. Price. A plat of the cmetyry was also submitted to the Cass County Historical Society.

These burial sites have all been identified with letters and markings on the map in the approximate location.

- A. SW part of Section 15 Township 44 Range 32. Slaves are thought to be buried at this site.
- B. NE part of Section 15 Township 44 Range 32.
- C. SW part of Section 34 Township 44 Range 31. This site is about ½ mile south of Pleasant Ridge Church on the west side of the road near the top of the ridge. Some graves were moved from here to Pleasant Ridge when that cemetery was established.
- D. SE part of Section 2 township 44 Range 31.
- E. Center part of NE¼ of Section 3 Township 44 Range 31. This site, known as Small Pox Cemetery, is north of what is now called the Duncan Quarry north of No. 2 Highway. The tradition is that during the Small Pox epidemics of the 1850's long trenches were dug and persons who died of this disease would be buried there by their families - often by night.

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
