

 On Sunday last, Capt. Barnes, of the Eleventh Mo. Regiment, captured three secesh prisoners near Hunnewell, in Monroe county. Their names were James Ridgway, John Lastree, and James Price. As they were returning, the soldiers were fired on from the bushes, when the prisoners ran and attempted to escape. The soldiers fired on them as they ran, and killed all three of them.
