"Death Of James Lasley"

One of three rebels killed on July 12, 1862, near Hunnewell, Missouri by Captain Barnes' company. Some of his men went to the Salt River bridge to arrest the three men. After they were arrested and on their way, the party was fired upon by someone in the brush. The three fled and were ordered to halt, but did not, and were immediately shot. One was instantly killed, the other lived but a few minutes, and the third one was left and supposed to have been mortally wounded. The funeral of two of them took place on July 26, 1862. The other two men were Joel Ridgeway and James Price.
