Bio on FindaGrave Mastin came to Pike County, Missouri around 1828 and eventually owned a large farm on the Old Frankfort Road, near Arthur's Bend. He owned slaves and raised tobacco. Mastin kept a keg of whiskey at his gate to refresh passersby. This might explain why he was elected County Assessor 1848-1856, Sheriff 1856-1860 and Public Administrator 1860-1872. Mastin and Bersheba were the parents of six children, two died in infancy. The four we know of are, John James Arthur, William B. Arthur, Jane Emeline Arthur and Nancy Arthur

Those left to mourn her death are three daughters, Mrs. Anna Glascock, Mrs. Ella Thornton and Mrs. Sallie Truitt. She joined the Bethel Baptist Church, Ralls County, Missouri in 1846 and Rev. William Broaddus baptized her. Betsy died on 4 Oct 1900 after a nineteen day hospital stay. Funeral services were held on 5 Oct 1900 and was officiated by Rev. J. D. Biggs. Betsy is interred in Biggs-Johnson Family Cemetery.
